what is the next XO ?

> The XO is no longer a choice for a deployment


- End of life of the device
- Price is not competitive
- Sold only by OLPC



> Tablets are the prefered device for education

- « 90% students agree that tablets will change the way students learn in the future » (Pearson Student Mobile Device Study, May 2014)
 - *« Almost 70% primary and secondary schools in the UK now use tablets »* (Barbie Clarke, <u>Kids and Youth research group</u>, Dec. 2014)


> Features:

- Create the #1 platform for deployment of learning devices in a school
- \succ A bundle of:
 - A multi-device learning platform: Sugarizer



• A server tool to manage and handle deployment: Sugarizer Server



what's next?

- Improved Client:
 - Login system to authent. and synch. user content
 - Instrumentation on activity usage
- \succ A centralized dashbord:
 - Statistics: activities, usage, journal, ...
 - Detailed access to storage



- Flashing tool for new device setup
- Local application store for APK
